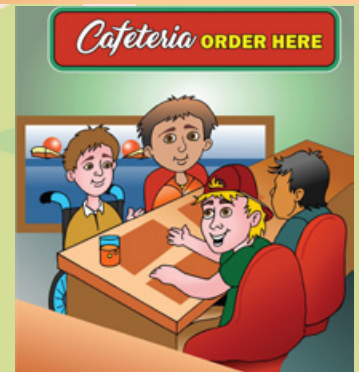
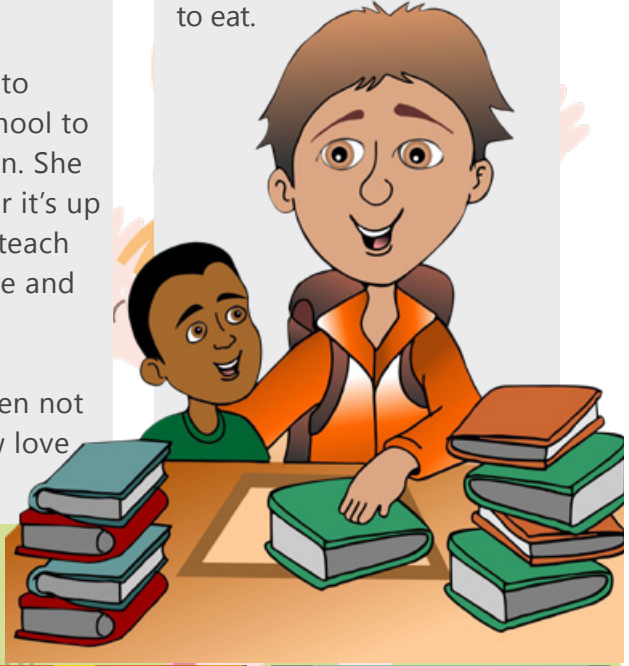
Little Remy is now starting the 4th grade.

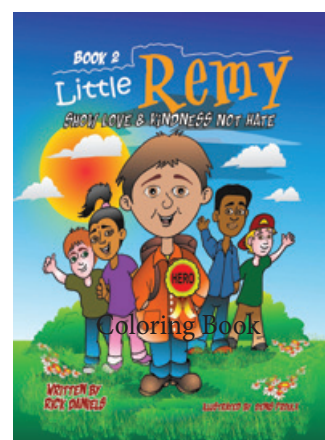
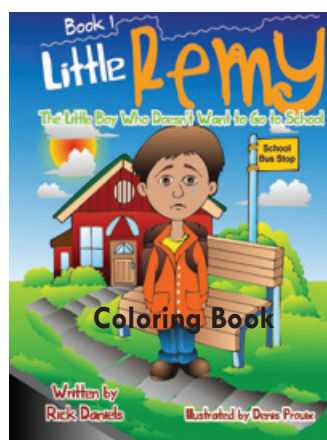
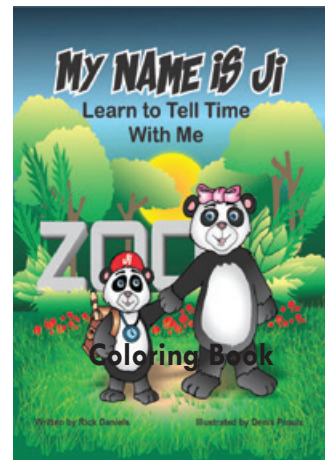
